There may be times in school when you need to speak to someone about any worries or concerns you have.

REMEMBER! You can talk to any member of staff in school. Here are some of the people in school that are here to help...

Form Tutor

First point of call for any problems or questions. They will be able to advise you or pass your issue to the right person.

Class Teacher

Concerns about work or a subject? Talk to your class teacher. Do this early to stop the problem growing.

Head of Department

If you are worried about your set or progress, a teacher in charge of a subject might be able to help.

Head of Year

Bigger problems with behaviour, friendships, general wellbeing. Speak to your head of year or pastoral lead.

Pastoral Manager

Bigger problems with behaviour, friendships, general wellbeing. Speak to the pastoral manager.

Assistant/Deputy & Headteacher

Can be spoken to, especially in emergencies, but try and speak to one of the other options first.
